SGT Gregory Campbell, son of Melvin and Doreen Campbell was born October 22, 1977 in Kingston, Jamaica.

He attended Kingston College in Jamaica from 1990 to 1995, where he was a member of KC's Rugby Team. After completing his High School studies, he went to work with the local Bottling Company D&G for a few years before migrating to the United States.

He then served in the United States Air Force from December 16, 1998 to August 3, 1999. SGT Campbell had a break in service, and then enlisted in the South Carolina National Guard as an 88M, Heavy Vehicle Driver on June 30, 2007. He deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan with Bravo Battery, 1st Battalion, 178th Field Artillery in February 2010. SGT Campbell was assigned to Alpha and Charlie Companies, Warrior Transition Battalion, Fort Gordon, Georgia. SGT Campbell's awards and decorations include the Good Conduct Medal, the Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the Armed Forces Reserve Medal with M device, the Air Force Training Ribbon, the Army Service Ribbon, the South Carolina Meritorious Service Medal, the South Carolina Mobilization Ribbon, and the South Carolina Palmetto Service Medal.
