Reflections of Life

Born and raised in Kershaw, South Carolina and later moving to Philadelphia, PA at the age of thirteen. **Conney** was a comic book fanatic as a child.

Conney enlisted in the US Army in 1952 and completed his service in 1955, where he earned the Korean Service Medal with one Bronze Star, UN Service Medal and the National Defense Service Medal. Upon returning to Philadelphia, Conney met his future wife, Mozella Thomas and they married in 1957. He joined the Masons October 1964 St. John Lodge 405.

Conney and Mozella moved to Paterson, NJ where they resided for fifty years and raised three beautiful daughters.

Conney worked for the Youth Detention Center, Rahway Prison and Northern State Prison before retiring as a Corrections Sergeant in 1995. Conney later came out of retirement to work for Tully House in Newark as a Supervisor. Conney returned to military service in 1982 in the National Guard until retiring in 1999 as a Staff Sergeant. Conney enjoyed playing solitaire, watching Jeopardy and Wheel of Fortune, his favorite artist was Jerry Butler (Ice Man). Conney opened Intensity Lounge in 1987 and closed it in 1999.

Conney and Mozella finally retired to Middletown, DE in 2007, where he resided until his sudden passing on May 15, 2011.

Conney was preceded in death by his mother and stepfather, Lucille and James Wilson. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife, Mozella Fletcher; his three daughters, Constance J. Fletcher and Sonya L. Fletcher of Middletown, DE and Tammy G.
