

Obituary

Fritzner Estiverne was born in Jacmel, Haiti on June 23, 1972. He was the first child of his father, Fritz Estiverne and mother, Marie Marthe F. Cayemitte. He departed from this earthly life on Friday, May 27, 2011. Fritz was thirty-eight years old, and just short of his thirty-ninth birthday.

Fritzner and his father were very close; he spent his early childhood with him until his mother took him into a boarding school for boys. Fritzner and his family left Haiti when he was about thirteen years old. They lived in Brooklyn, New York for a short time and as a teen, he moved to Englewood, NJ where he attended and graduated from Dwight-Morrow High School in 1991. He enjoyed the love and friendship from his mother, Marie, his step dad, Jean Herold and cousin, Justin. They had a very close loving relationship. The next fall he attended Montclair State College, in Montclair, New Jersey where he studied Criminal Justice, Business, and Marketing. While attending college, he met and fell in love with Melvina Dunston and through this union two sons were born.

Constantly planning his next move, Fritz became a Savvy Promoter and Budding Entrepreneur making a name as an Entertainment Industry Tastemaker in the tri-state area. Starting a promotion company, with two partners, Three Stoogez Entertainment blossomed to be synonymous with the "it" parties in the Northern New Jersey area. There were few scenes between New York and New Jersey where the name "Fritz Q" did not ring bells. He mixed in with the celebrity circles with the same calm and flair as he did amongst the everyday person yet with a distinct aura of his own. However, Fritzner's vision exceeded just the party scene. He soon branched out on his own to add multi-media ventures, music artist management, youth talent showcasing, and industry conventions to his resume, making even more valuable connections along the way. In the mean time always maintaining two jobs, a well known barber at Cut Creations in Teaneck, New Jersey and several positions in the communications and retail industries to support his family and fuel his movements, surely Fritzner's work was far from done.

Fritzner had a kind and giving heart, he always kept his sons close to him and he made sure he told them he loved them everyday. He loved his family the most and anyone who spent time with Fritzner within moments knew his family always came first. Fritzner often gave to everyone without expecting anything in return, he touched many lives and he will never be forgotten.

Fritzner was predeceased by his father, Fritz Estiverne. He leaves behind to cherish his memory: his loving mother, Marie M.
