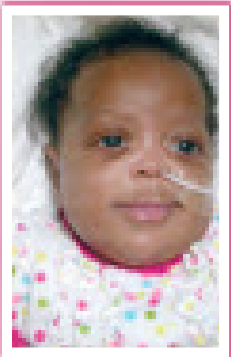

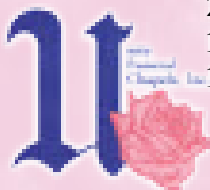
*God on his throne in Heaven
