

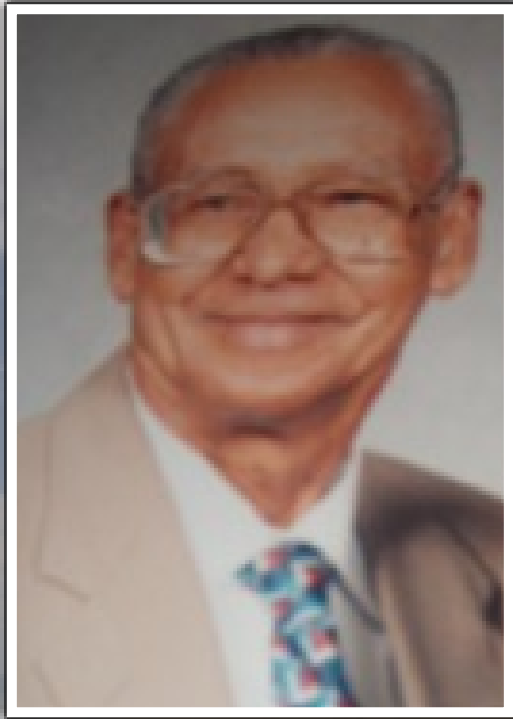

## *Obituary*

Former resident of Englewood, NJ, **Sydney A. Walsh**, 86, died August 23, 2011, at the Dumont Nursing Home in New Rochelle, New York, leaving behind his wife, Shirley Walsh and family.

Mr. Walsh was born October 30, 1924, in Kingston, Jamaica, to Lloyd and Mirvis Walsh.

Sydney was an accomplished craftsman and master cabinetmaker and made many fine pieces of furniture in his lifetime.

Mr. Walsh served as a salesman for General Motors Jamaica for many years and won multiple awards for salesman of the year. In 1986, Mr. Walsh migrated to the United States with his family where he became a security officer for the Fairleigh Dickinson University. He was also a very active member at Community Baptist Church and served as an usher as long as he was physically able.

Always the consummate family man, Mr. Walsh mandated daily family devotions and planned weekend excursions for family recreation.

Sydney is one of nine children and is survived by: sisters, Beverly, Rose, Elaine, Camille - (sunshine) and Edna; brothers, Hugh and Frankie. He was also predeceased by his sister, Hazel. Mr. Walsh fathered ten children, Olive, Audrey, Janet, Frankie, Paul, Lloyd, Sherman, Norma, Christine and Peter. He also leaves behind eighteen grandchildren; and a host of great grandchildren, cousins, nephews, nieces and family members.
