Deacon Edward Ezekiel Bratton was born July 4, 1948 to Charles and Rebecca Bratton in Columbia, South Carolina.

Edward attended grammar school in South Carolina and later relocated to Jersey City, New Jersey, where he attended Snyder High School, played football and graduated with honors. He also played for the Wilkies Basketball team. After graduating high school, he

attended Princeton University, Lincoln University, then graduating from Jersey City State College.

Ed's work experience included Block Drugs, American Can Company and Ryerson Steele, he also briefly worked as a long shore man. He was a teacher for the Jersey City School District, before he became employed for the United States Postal Service for thirty-eight years.
