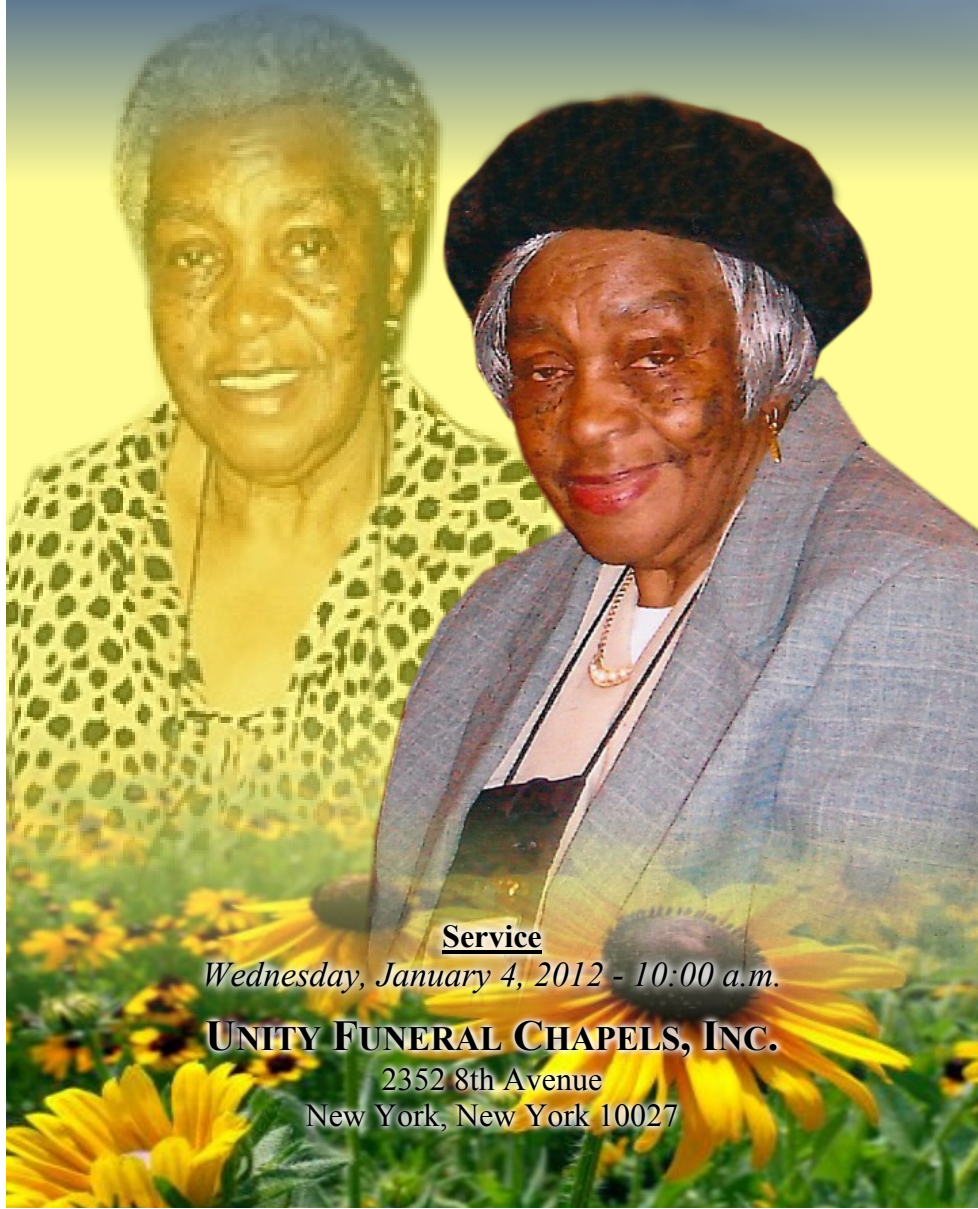

## Obituary
