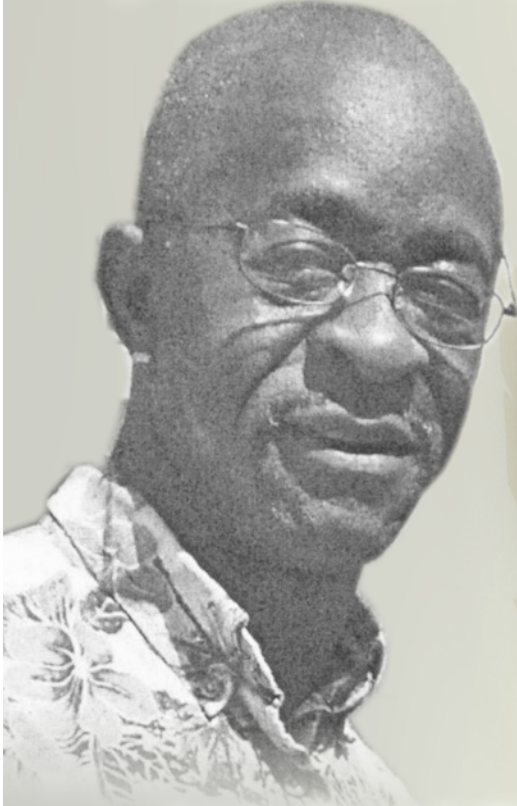

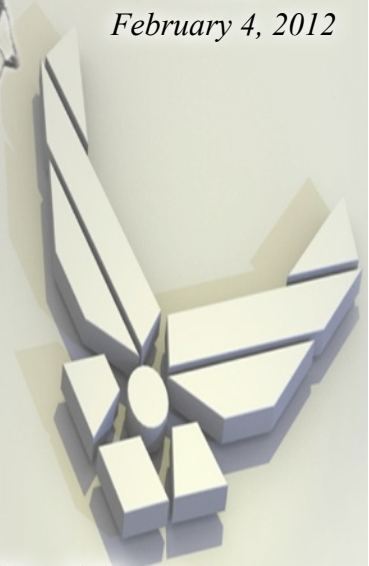


Sunrise
