Mamie Rose Williams was born on January 22, 1924 in Gastonia, North Carolina, daughter of Cynthia and Julius Caldwell. Raised in Gastonia, she was educated in the Gastonia Public School System.

On July 4, 1940, she was joined in holy matrimony to James Williams. This union was blessed with two daughters, Barbara and Katie. They moved to Roselle, New Jersey where they would live from 1942 to 1953 before settling in Linden, New Jersey.

Mother Williams was Mother of the Church and a Missionary at Apostolic Outreach in Linden. She was a former member of White Rock Baptist Church in Linden where she sang with the Senior Choir for many years. She also sang and travelled with the Crusade Choir in Newark, New Jersey under the direction of Brother Sam Robinson.

In 1991, Mrs. Williams received a certificate in Evangelism from the Eastern Bible College in Irvington, New Jersey. She also obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Christian Education in 1993.

Mrs. Williams had served as President and Secretary for the New Jersey State Commission for the Blind, an organization that she was very proud to work with. She was also a member of the Mt. Carmel Guild.
