## *Obituary*

**Malcolm Alexander Mascall**, age 81, of Cedar Grove, Antigua went home to be with the Lord, Tuesday, February 21, 2012.

Malcolm Alexander Mascall was born April 3, 1930 in Cedar Grove Village, Antigua to Victor Mascall and Alice Warner, both whom preceded him in death. He was called home on February 21, 2012 at Colombia Presbyterian Hospital, Manhattan, New York. He was a faithful member of St. Mary's Anglican Church, Bronx, New York.

Malcolm Mascall attended the Cedar Grove Primary School, Antigua. Upon graduation, he went on to trade school where he became a master carpenter. He worked on numerous construction projects throughout the island to include Curtain Bluff Hotel & Mill Reef Club. Later, he was employed at the American Air Station, where he worked in the carpentry shop, until his departure to the United States. In 1983 Malcolm migrated to New York City. There he became a union carpenter and worked on such jobs as the Westside Highway & Riker's Island construction projects. He retired in 1991 and resided at 1199 Plaza until God called him home.
