

Hubert Ray Edwards (Baby Ray/ Huey) made his transition to be with the Lord on May 24, 2012, at Overlook Hospital in Summit, NJ. He was born on January 29, 1943 in Wilson, North Carolina to the late James Yelverton and Hilderine Edwards and nurtured by his aunt, the late Rosa Yelverton (Aunt Sissy).

Hubert moved to Newark, New Jersey after graduating from high school. He served in the United States Army from 1961 – 1967. He traveled throughout Europe including Germany and Denmark. In August of 1969, he was united in holy matrimony to Betty Slater

Hubert maintained employment with several jobs until he was gainfully employed with Ford Motor Company in Edison, New Jersey. During his tenure with Ford Motor Company, he was a dedicated worker. He began working on the assembly line and then on to the role of Computer Trainer for the plant employees during the introduction of robotics and computerized machinery at the plant in 1987. After he successfully maintained his employment for many years he retired in 1998. He also enjoyed working in the family business at his father's store, Jim's Wines & Liquors in Elizabeth, New Jersey.

On December 13, 1998, Brother Edwards united with Faith Temple #1 Original Free Will Baptist Church, East Orange, New Jersey under the leadership of Bishop L.N. Forbes. He later was appointed by Bishop Forbes as a Trustee and served faithfully. He recently served as the Co-Chairman of the Trustees' Ministry.

Hubert knew that he was blessed because he was a two-time cancer survivor! He always smiled and knew how to bring forth a smile in others through laughter. He was full of jokes, a true comedian at heart. At any gathering, he would often have something amusing to say or tell funny stories just to have a good time. He always made sure that his suit, hat and shoes were well put together.
