

## *To Those I Love*

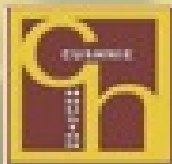
*To those I love and those that love me,

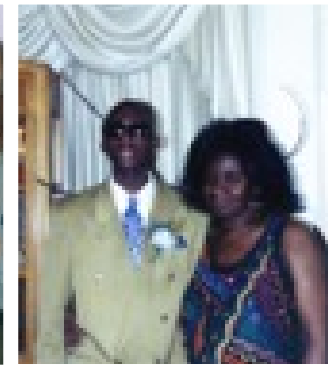
