Both brothers brought nothing but joy and happiness to their parents and family, especially their grandma who they loved running to greet her at the door after she would arrive home from work. During their brief visit on earth, Kenley and Kendell enjoyed spending time together playing, dancing, counting and singing. There most favorite songs were the "Alphabet Song" and "Oh MacDonald Had a Farm".

Kenley always shared his love for school and recently graduated out of pre-K. This fall Kenley was preparing to enter Kindergarten. He liked going on class trips and always talked about his favorite teacher Ms. Valerie. On Kenley's free time, he loved watching his favorite shows: Caillou, Little Bill, and Phineas and Ferb. His favorite characters were Batman and Spiderman. Kenley's favorite vegetable was broccoli and he often reminded his dad that exercising and eating healthy is good for you. Kenley always requested to have his birthday parties at Chuckie Cheese.

Everywhere Kenley went, Kendell followed right behind him. Anything Kenley had, Kendell had to have also. Kendell also had his favorite shows to watch too and would always ask his uncle Wismy to change to his favorites: Power Rangers, Dragon Ball Z, and SpongeBob SquarePants. Like his brother his favorite characters were Batman and Spiderman. Kendell enjoyed eating pizza, chicken, bananas, popsicles, and ice cream and loved asking grandma for rice.

Both were mommy's little boys and loved spending time with her and making her laugh.
