

## Obituary

Arthur Lee Spurling was born on February 29, 1940 in Donora, Pennsylvania, to the late Elisha James Spurling and the late Ida Mae (Roddy) Spurling. He passed away on July 23, 2012 at the age of seventy-two. The family relocated later to Queens, New York from Donora during the 1950's. Lee, as he preferred to be called, graduated from Flushing High School, where he was active on the Football and Track teams. He also ventured out as an entrepreneur at Five Brothers Steak House located in Laurelton, NY. He met the love of his life, Beverly in 1985 and married her in 1989. That union

was blessed with three wonderful sons, Jason, Alexander and Evan.

Lee had many attributes, he was "the life of the party", proud (never walked with his head down), humorous (loved telling jokes or funny stories), knowledgeable (especially in African American, American and Cinema History), loved to dance (knew the latest dances from the fifties and sixties) and sing (he thought he was Nat "King" Cole and Smokey Robinson and Jackie Wilson). He also loved Jazz and the Motown Sound

Lee enjoyed sports, such as boxing (competed while in the Marines), martial arts (in which he made it to the Green Belt) football (Semi Professional Football in which he was a member of the Elmhurst Red Devils Team).

Overall Lee loved life and loved his family, especially his children. He wanted his children to definitely be all that they could be in society and to enjoy life to the fullest.

Lee is survived by: his loving wife, Beverly H. Spurling; children, Sonya Anita Spurling (ex-wife, Anna Lee Spurling), Jason Anthony Cecil Spurling, Pfc Alexander Noel Elijah Spurling; daughter-in-law, Vicky Spurling and Evan Xavier Ross Spurling; siblings, Junetta S.
