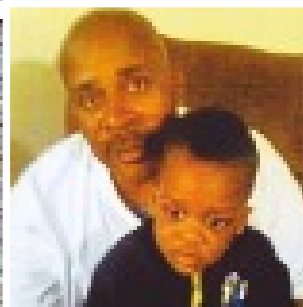
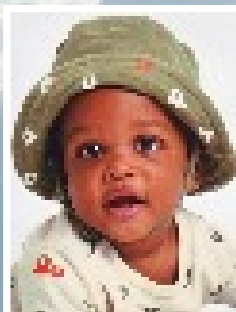
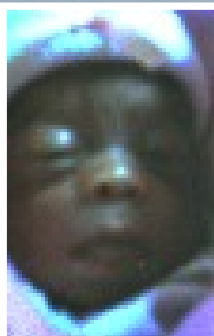


A Thank You Note
