Reflections of Life

George Nelson Coultman was born in Kingston, Jamaica on March 7, 1915. He was an only child of the union of his parents Thaddeus Luis Coultman and Atilla Kelly. George N. Coultman was an automobile body mechanic, a body and fender repairman, by trade, until he relocated to the United States of America.

In New York George left his original trade behind and became an attendant at Byrd S. Coler Memorial Hospital, Roosevelt Island. It is now Coler/Goldwater. He was employed there in the excess of fifty years. During that time, he earned his High School Equivalency Diploma.

In addition, contemporaneously, George holds an Associate of Science degree in Nursing from Pace University. At Coler, following his state boards, he became a Registered Nurse and a Supervisor of Nursing. He then became the holder of a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from Saint Francis College.

George is survived by his daughter, Yvonne M. Mouton, and sons, Joseph L. Coultman and Edmund A. Coultman. In addition, there are numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.
