Bobby (Ray Ellis) worked on a Newark School Project performing for numerous Elementary School children and Universities under the leadership of Mr. Edward Hardy.

He was preceded in death by his only daughter, Aretha Jones, youngest brother, Reginald Cooper and Keisha Jordon.
