<u>Obituary</u>

Tyrone B. Rodriguez, Sr. was born on April 9, 1942. He was the fifth and youngest child of the late Dorothy and Harold Rodriguez. Tyrone grew up in Harlem and was educated in the Roman Catholic parochial and NYC public school systems.

As a young adult, Tyrone enlisted in the United States Army and he spent much of his service time in Berlin, Germany. He received an honorable discharge from the Army in 1966. Tyrone later entered the NYC Police Academy and trained to become a Police Officer. He was proudly appointed to the NYPD on March 14, 1969 and was assigned to precincts in his beloved Harlem community.

In 1973, Tyrone met the love of his life. He married his wife, Georgianna Rodriguez, on October 3, 1975. The following year he became the very proud father of his son, Tyrone, Jr. He cherished his role as provider and protector of his family. Tyrone and Georgianna renewed their wedding vows at Saint Helena's Church on their 11th and 25th wedding anniversaries.

Tyrone enjoyed spending time with his son and his son's friends. He served as the Assistant Coach on his son's Parkchester Little League Baseball Team and as Scoutmaster to Troop 65 at Saint Helena's Church. He was a mentor and father figure to his nephews, nieces and many of his son's childhood and college friends.

Tyrone retired from the NYPD in 1989 and went on to work in, and later retire from, the security department at Our Lady of Mercy Medical Center. During his retirement, he enjoyed traveling with his wife. He also enjoyed spending the holidays with his immediate family and in-laws enjoying good food, good company and football. The peak of his happiness was simply being in the comfort of his home.

As a result of complications from his long battle with a rare and progressive dementia, Tyrone was admitted to Montefiore Medical Center on August 22, 2012. The Lord gently called him home on Sunday, October 14, 2012.
