

<u>Obituary</u>

Anella Roma Johnson age 58 of Baltimore, Maryland entered peacefully into rest on Wednesday, October 10, 2012 at 11:25 a.m. at Gilchrist Hospice Centre in Towson, Maryland. Anella was born on February 12, 1954 to Kenneth Johnson Sr. and Esmine Johnson in Claremont, St. Ann, Jamaica West Indies.

She attended Claremont Primary School and Ferncourt High School and studied Nursing at Lewisham Hospital in the United Kingdom. In 1978, she migrated to the United States where she lived in New York, working consecutively with Beth Israel Medical Center, Baptist Medical Center, Manhattan Psychiatric Center and Kings County Hospital.

While working at Manhattan Psychiatric Center, Anella met Eric Shaw, now deceased. They were married in 1981, and from that union were born two sons, Wayne Shaw of New Jersey and Kyle Shaw of Maryland. Recognizing that she needed more flexibility to raise her children, Anella joined the staff at St. Mary's Hospital as a Field Nurse.

She worked with the Visiting Nurse Association of Brooklyn, Interfaith Home Care, and Personal Touch Nursing. In 2007, she moved to West Palm Beach, Florida, where she worked with the Redi Nurse Service. In 2009, she returned to her job at St. Mary's Hospital. When her mother became ill later that year she moved back to Florida to care for her.

In 2010, while living in New Jersey and working at St. Mary's Hospital, Anella became ill. For the next two years, Anella lived in Florida and Baltimore, where she received treatment. Her long battle with her illness ended while she was surrounded by family and friends.

Throughout her working life, her passion was in the area of Community Nursing. Anella was known for her kindness, patience, and an ability to manage difficult patients. She was a member of the Corona Seventh Day Adventist Church, Queens, New York and served faithfully in the Soup Kitchen program.

Anella is survived by her two sons, Wayne and Kyle Shaw; her mother, Esmine Johnson; brothers, Larkland Meed, Glenworth Green and Winston Green (Jamaica), Michael Johnson and Ashlin Johnson (New York), and Kenneth Johnson (Maryland). She is also survived by sisters, Asneth Green-Watt (Florida), Vivienne Roberts (Barbados), Marjorie Keen (Jamaica), Jacqueline Boykin (Florida), Melanie Johnson (Florida), Karen Johnson (Maryland), Judith Johnson (New Jersey), Rose Johnson (Jamaica), and Denise Johnson (Florida). She also leaves to mourn her passing many nieces, nephews, grand nieces, grand nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins and in-laws, too many to mention individually.
