Raymond Sanderlin was born and raised in Passaic, NJ to William K. and Edith Mae (Byard) Sanderlin.

Mr. Sanderlin was a World War II Veteran who served as a VFW in Germany, receiving several ribbons, The American Theater Ribbon and The European African Middle Eastern Ribbon along with The Good Conduct and Victory Medals. After his honorable discharge in 1946 he worked for The Ford Motor Company in Mahwah, NJ and Flintkote in Passaic, NJ. He was employed at ITT Avionics in Nutley, NJ until his retirement in 1987.

He was predeceased by his parents, William K. and Edith Mae (Byard) Sanderlin, brothers, Robert, Edward, James and William Sanderlin and sister, Miriam "Mickey" Branch.

Raymond entered into eternal rest on Tuesday, October 30, 2012.

He is survived by his brother, Deacon Floyd Sanderlin (Mary); sisters, Norma Mann and Lillian Roseborough of Passaic, NJ; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends who truly miss him.
