Deacon Alfred Underwood was born April 5, 1959 in Birmingham, Alabama to Ruth Underwood and the late Clarence Chappelle.

Deacon Underwood accepted Christ as his personal Savior at an early age at Calvary Baptist Church, Garfield, NJ, under the pastorage of the late Rev. Joseph J. Robinson.
