## <u>Obituary</u>

After attending High School he entered into the United States Navy and spent twelve years traveling all over the world. He traveled throughout Europe and his favorite country was Cuba where he traveled intensively until Fidel Castro threw out all Americans.

After his stint in the United States Navy, he worked as a New York Taxi Driver and attended Night School to become a Mechanical Draftsman because of his love of drawing. He knew how to prepare technical drawings by hand showing the detail and assembly of a wide variety of machinery and mechanical devises under the direction of an engineer. He helped to design a lot of factories in Japan. Jacob worked at Bulova Watch Company in Woodside Queens, New York until the company became part of the Loews Corporation in 1979. After this time Jacob worked various jobs until he retired at the New Jersey Postal Office.

Also during this time he met Dorothy Roberts who became his wife and they also traveled intensively all over the world such as Panama and in the United States to places such as Maryland and Florida. Jacob retired due to an illness.
