Horace (Easy) James Coakieanos, was the second child born to Vickee Lynn and Jerome Coakieanos. He was born on the 12th of April, 1965 at Womack Army Hospital in Fort Bragg, North Carolina.

Horace was educated at St. Paul's Elementary in Prospect Park and Eastside High School in Paterson, both in New Jersey. Upon graduation, Horace was employed by numerous companies. His most recent employer was Care Plus Laundry in Passaic, New Jersey.
