Reflections of Life

Isaac Suber, Jr. (known as **Sonny** to the family) was born in Columbia, SC on January 10, 1928 to the late Isaac Suber, Sr. and Mary Bates Suber.

The family moved to NJ when he was a toddler. Isaac attended public school in Paterson, NJ where he excelled in track at Eastside High School.

In his youth, he was the drum major for First A.M.E. Zion Church's Boy Scout band, and was an air raid warden for his block during the early part of World War II. At the age of seventeen years, he enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard serving on the Admiral H.T. Mayo Transport Ship in the Pacific. He received an honorable discharge.

He was married to Lois Moore Suber from 1948 to 2008 until God called her home. From this union four children were born, Monte, Gary, Sr., Priscilla and Lois. He married Julia Beamon Ballard-Suber in 2009 and from this union two stepdaughters, Brenda Prince and Yvonne Ballard were added to the family.

He was a member of New A.M.E. Zion Church for over fifty years. He served on the Executive Board, Men's Day Committee, Men of Zion and Boy Scout Committee and with the Troop. He was honored by the Sunday School in 1994.

Isaac was known for making his special spaghetti sauce for the Vacation Bible School each year. He was also known for his delicious sweet potato pies.

He was a Passaic County Master Board Worker and Voting Machine Technician for the City of Paterson.

He worked for PSE&G in electric production for many years. After receiving his red and black seal licenses, he continued taking further courses and training. In 1979, he received his Gold Seal Engineering License from the State of New Jersey, and became an Electrical Engineer Instructor for PSE&G until his retirement in 1993.

He loved attending Church, spending time with family, traveling, gospel and jazz music. He enjoyed sports and was an avid Mets fan.

Isaac departed this life on January 9, 2013 at the Wayne View Nursing Home, Wayne, NJ.
