Walter also loved to dance and has participated in many dance contests sponsored by I.B.P.O.E of W.Elks and Masons. He was "Mr. Suave" and "lite on his feet". In addition to his love of dancing he also loved to swim.

Walter participated and won a 1st place medal for Olympic swimming in New York. In his later years after retirement water sports proved to be extremely therapeutic. He loved life and we will miss him dearly; he has been relieved of his suffering and has gone where there is no hurt or pain.
