
At an early age Christine became a member of Macedonia Baptist Church in Edgefield, SC.

I turned my back and left it all.*

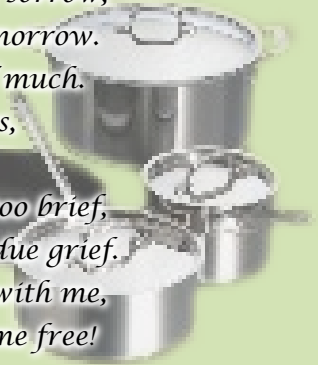
*I could not stay another day.
