Beverly was a wonderful mother, wife and grandmother. A strong woman, Beverly raised her five siblings at a young age due to the loss of her parents.

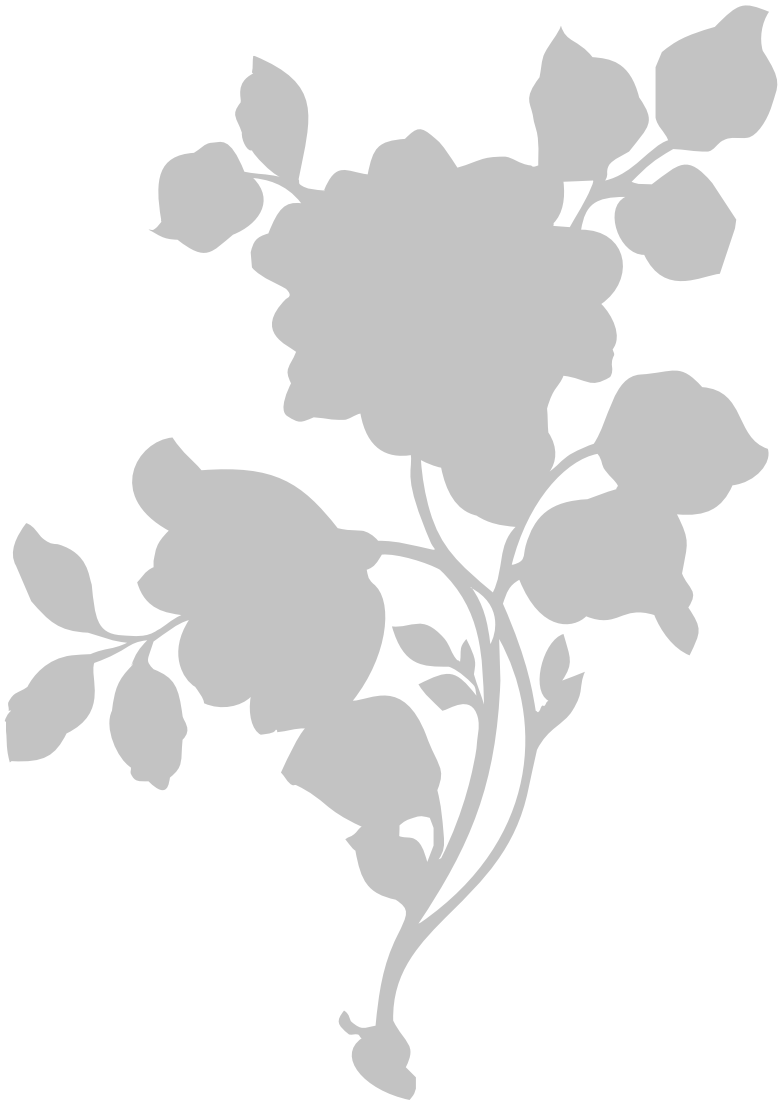
