

Reflections of Life

Alexander Seymour fondly known as "Uncle Ralph" or "Mr. Seymour" to family and friends was born on August 18, 1932 in the Parish of St. Mary Jamaica, West Indies to the late Mr. and Mrs. Finyest Seymour. He was the fourth of five children.

As a young man, Mr. Seymour worked for the Coca Cola Bottling Company. A job that would span two countries. After migrating to the United States in 1965, he continued to work for Coca Cola which at the time was located on Route 20 N. in Paterson, NJ. He would eventually retire from Coca Cola after several decades of service.

Mr. Seymour was the kind of person that would serve you even if you didn't have any money. He was giving and would sometimes put others before himself. Despite his struggle with diabetes, Mr. Seymour was still living life to the fullest traveling to Jamaica and Florida to visit family and friends as well as hanging out at his favorite spot on Tenth Ave. In early 2000, Mr. Seymour accepted the Lord as his Saviour and was baptized.

He was preceded in death by his son, Chev, daughter, Edna, sister, Agatha and step daughter, Maureen.

Mr. Alexander Seymour departed this life on Tuesday, January 29, 2013 quietly at home.

He leaves to cherish wonderful memories: his loving wife of forty-four years, Mabel Seymour; daughters, Angela "June", Sonia, Jackey and son, Leroy. He also leaves a special great grandson, Desan Lewis that was always there for him, along with his other grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and cousins that he loved and adored.
