leaves or excess grass to make sure the street was always clean.

Jeffrey was received into the arms of a loving God, who brought him out of harm's way to his eternal reward on April 7, 2013 at his home surrounded by his loved ones. He was predeceased by two sisters, Cassandra G. Lane, Chauncey D. Fields and mother-in-law, Rose E. Cunningham-Bemory; all who loved him dearly as he did them.
