

She furthered her education at the Passaic Beauty Academy and later at Rutgers University where she received an Associate's degree in Early Childhood Education.

Mrs. Young was employed for several years at Revlon Cosmetics before pursuing her passion of working with children as a teacher's aide at Passaic Head Start for over ten years and at Urban Crisis Daycare Center in Passaic, NJ for over thirty-two years.

Mrs. Young met the love of her life Perno "Slick" Young Sr., in 1948 and they were wed in holy matrimony on November 25, 1948. Eight children were born as a result of this union, June, Regina, Diane, Perno, John, Marcia, Brenda, Paula. She also had a beloved younger brother who was raised in the home, David Cason.
