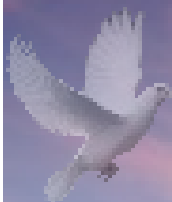
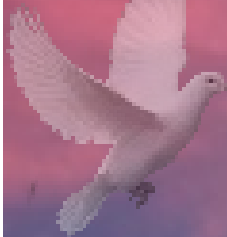

Obituary
