Charlene loved working and was employed by the City of New York and the Agency aptly named the Human Resources Administration (HRA) in Brooklyn, New York for seventeen years. She started out as a Case Worker and worked her way up to being Manager as she worked in different departments initially. She was a diligent employee who loved her co-workers, always speaking fondly of them. She disliked not being able to go to work so much that she questioned why the City of New York gave days off for Holidays!

Being the last child conceived out of seven siblings, she was fondly known as the baby of the Thomas Clan. She was truly adored by her older brothers and sisters alike. Possessed with a wonderful personality, a beautiful smile and humorous wit, she was always a joy to be around. Charlene was always the life of the party as she hosted most of them for her family and friends. She also had an affinity for playing cards, particularly Bid Wiz and Spades. If you were not good, you didn't want to play with her, because she was good and she would tell you if you were not! The Great Charlene Thomas!
