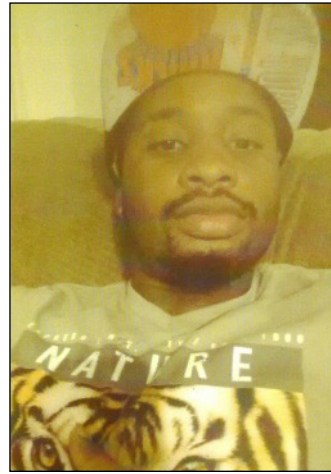

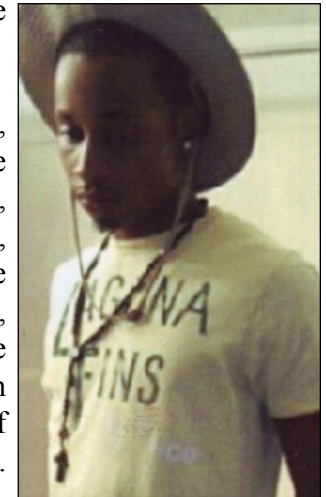
Rajhon was educated in the Newark Public School system. He proceeded his education on to high school where he graduated the year 2009 from Malcolm X Shabazz High School.
