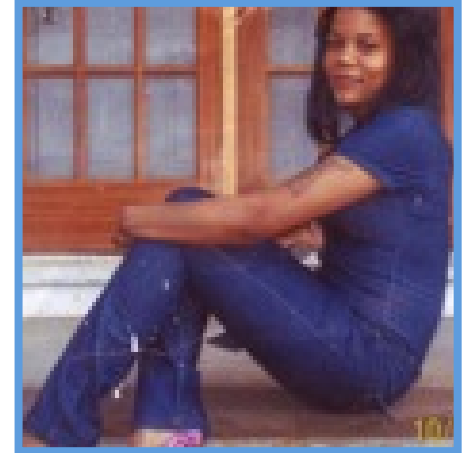

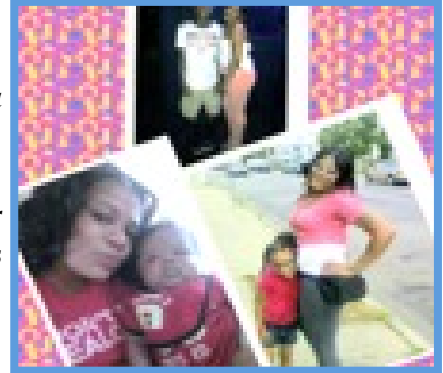


# *Reflections of Life*
