Viola Henderson also known as “Ma” and “Ms.Vi”, was born the last day of December 1926 in Camden, SC to the late George and Fannie Jones.

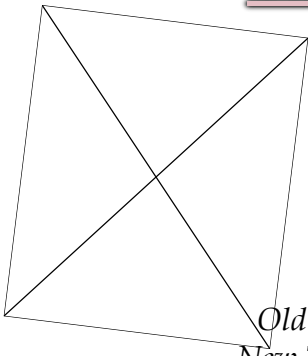

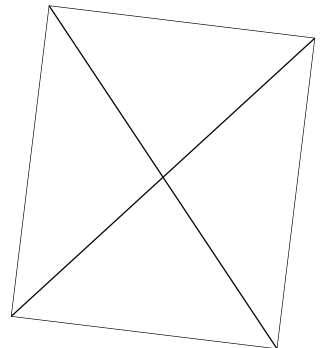
