## *Life Reflections*

**Eulalie Wheeler Johnson** was born on June 20, 1921 in Sumter, South Carolina, daughter of Arthur Wheeler and Mary Bruner Wheeler. She was educated in the Sumter, South Carolina Public School System. Later, she was employed as a cafeteria worker at Shaw Air Force Base in Sumter.

Eulalie was joined in holy matrimony to John Johnson and this union was blessed with 6 children, Edith, Corine Sugar, John "Fred", James B., Arthur A. and Larry. In 1966, they relocated to Roselle, New Jersey and Eulalie remained a resident there until her passing. She had worked as a domestic in the Union County area for many years.

Eulalie was a member of Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church in Roselle and attended faithfully until her health began to fail. She was a former member of Joshua Baptist Church in Sumter.

Eulalie Johnson departed this life on Wednesday, April 30, 2014 at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital in Rahway, New Jersey at the age of 92.
