Obituary

Sheila Elizabeth Cole was born on June 16, 1957 in Newark, NJ at Beth Israel Hospital to the late Nathan Cole and Naomi (Williams-Cole) Brannon. She departed this life on Saturday, May 3, 2014 at JFK Medical Center in Edison, NJ.

Sheila E. was the first born. Naomi and her two girls and “Aunt Peggy” relocated to East Orange, where she attended Kentopp/Stockton and Ashland Elementary Schools. Sheila E. graduated from East Orange High School in 1975. She then attended Lyons Institute where she received a certificate of completion as an accredited Phlebotomist. Sheila worked in the healthcare industry for several years with her last phlebotomy position at Beth Israel Medical Center’s Emergency Room. She then went on to work for the Arc of New Jersey assisting special needs young adults to live on their own.

Once Sheila was afflicted with a stroke 7-year ago, she recovered about 90% and while placed on permanent disability, Sheila was in training to work as an Event Planner at Agape Church in Rahway. She also worked remotely as a Customer Service Representative for Home Shoppers Network and 1-800 Flowers.

Sheila E. was born into the First Church of God in Christ - 14th Avenue and Hunterdon Street, Newark, NJ (3rd Generation.) She was an usher and a Bright Stars Choir member under Mother Geneva Holt; a Voices for Christ Choir member under Mother Barbara Bell. Later on, Sheila was a member of the Console Chorus, the Central District Choir and the First Jurisdictional State Choir as a Marshall leading the sopranos. Sheila was devoted to the Lord. Attending church, bible study, the prayer line, conferences and workshops were her passion and praising and worshipping the Lord God was her life!

Sheila was a devoted daughter, sister, aunt, cousin and friend. As her affliction began to think it had a hold of her, she continued to say, “Thank You, Jesus,” “Hallelujah,” “Praise God,” “Holy Ghost Power,” “I’m alright,” “I’ve got to go” “It’s beautiful there” and “I’m in NO Pain!” Even in her light affliction, God comforted her.
