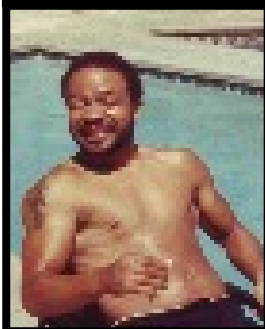
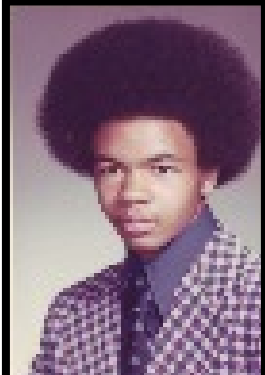
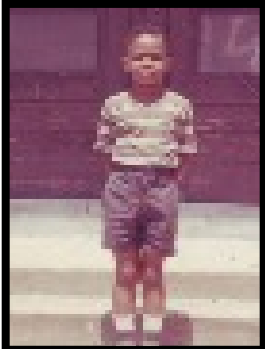
Norman J. Green, Jr. was born on November 13, 1956 to Trudina Wright and Norman J. Green, Sr.
