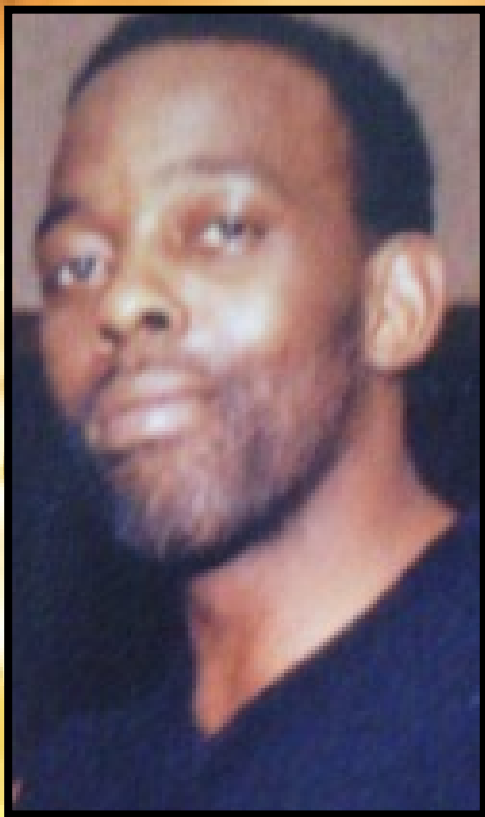

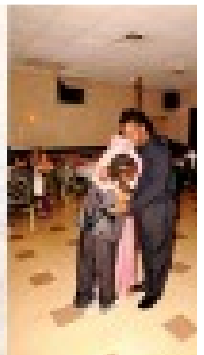
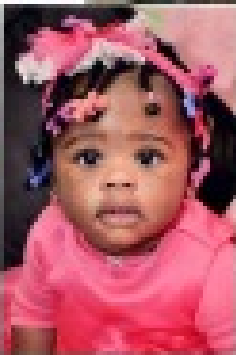
Shareek Lamont Curry was born to Evelyn Curry and the late Melvin Harrison on November 8, 1980 in Paterson, NJ.
