# Obituary

*Calvin A. Hill Jr. was born in Newark, New Jersey, on September 17, 1928, to the late Calvin A. Hill and Margaret Jackson. He was the second of three children.*

*As a child, he attended the Newark Public Schools. After graduation, he enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he was honorably discharged. He then began his 35 plus years of service at the United States Postal Service where he retired as a Manager of Distribution.*

*Calvin was united in marriage to the late Thelma Leonia Hill in 1969. With this union they created a blended family: Arnold and Wendy Denis, both of whom preceded him in death, Valerie Hill Jones, and Kia Hill Styles. They resided in Hillside, New Jersey, for 16 years before relocating to Princeton, New Jersey. In 2003, he and Thelma relocated to Katy, Texas, where he spent the last 11 years of his life. Calvin united with First Baptist Church and was baptized in 2002, and continued his fellowship after relocating to Katy.*

*To know Calvin was to laugh and smile. He could find humor even in tough situations. He developed a true love of golf and made it his favorite pastime when he retired. When he could no longer play golf, he would travel with his friends and ride the golf cart just to watch (and tease). Calvin also enjoyed traveling with his family and friends and loved listening to and supporting various jazz organizations.*
