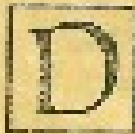
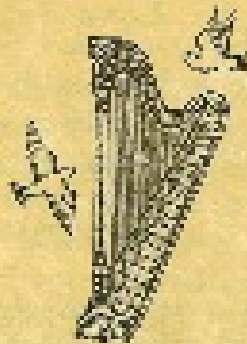
**O loving God, we send
