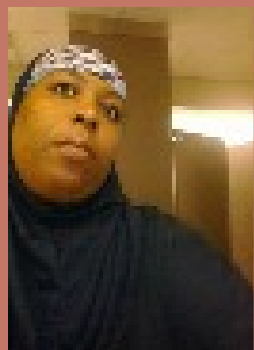
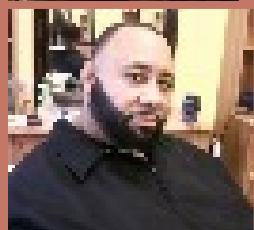
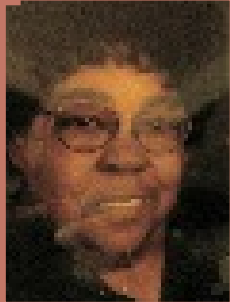

Camilla S. Ellerbe was born in Ridgewood, NJ on July 28, 1937 to the late Robert and Allie Smith.

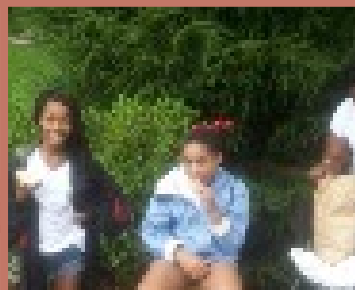
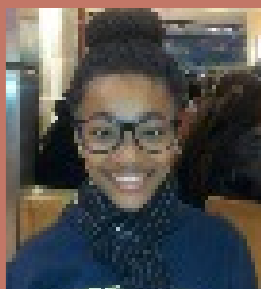
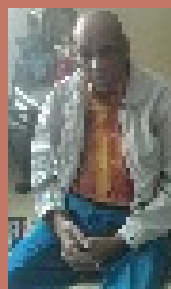
