Obituary

Alonzo Leroy Wilcher, Sr., second son of the late Winfred Fontaine and Willimae Wilcher was born in Chester, PA on December 12, 1933. He departed this life on Sunday, May 10, 2015 at JFK Hospital, Edison, NJ.

He received his early education in the Jersey City school system, graduating from Dickinson High School. Confessing Christ at an early age, he was baptized at Ocean Avenue Baptist Church by Rev. Ferman Means.

In September, 1956, he was united in marriage to Phyllis Austin. Of this union, three children were born, Phyllis Michele, Alonzo Leroy, Jr. and Bruce Edward.

He worked at Lightolier in Jersey City, GAF in Linden and after more than twenty-five years of service, in 2000, he retired from Schering Plough in Union, NJ.

He was sincere in his role as Deacon and took his responsibilities seriously, frequently visiting the sick and shut in.

He was preceded in death by his brother, William Wilcher.

Jeffrey), Alonzo, Jr. and Bruce (Kimberly); and an ex-wife, Phyllis Wilcher; six grandchildren, Shaun Young, Derek Young, Jessica Roberson, Brianna Wilcher, Erika Wilcher and Davion Wilcher; one great-granddaughter, Anjalina Young; and one sister-in-law, Lorraine Pitts.
