# Obituary

**Clifford Jones** was born on July 3, 1934, in Newark, New Jersey; the only son of Olerie Jones. Clifford entered eternal rest on June 1, 2015, God granting him eighty years he lived as a devout Christian.

Clifford spent his early years in Newark and also lived for a time with his mother in North Edison Potters Crossing section, where he was a member and attended Mount Zion Free Will Baptist Church.

And later lived in Colonia, New Jersey where he was a member of Colonia Baptist Church, pastored by Reverend Poindexter and later Reverend Lowe.

Upon his mother's death in the early 1980's, he became godson to Mrs. Dolores Caldwell; whom she considered him a "godsend" to her and she a second mother to him.

For the past twenty years, while living in Princeton and Ewing, New Jersey, Clifford was a faithful member of Princeton Deliverance Center Inc.; Bishop Odell and Reverend Rose Mary Bradley—Pastors .

Even on days he was not feeling his best, he was determined to make it to the House of God. Brother Jones was a willing saint. He was always ready to do whatever he could for his church.

It was his sincere desire to be a deacon, usher, play the congas, sing a song and testify for the Lord. He truly embodied the Scripture Psalms 100:4 "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise"—Brother Jones always came READY to praise the Lord. As soon as the music began he would jump up and dance. He always had a word of encouragement, a song and a dance for the Lord. He never let his disability hold him back from giving God the praise.

Left to cherish his memory are: his god brother, Sonny Caldwell; and wife Isata; a niece and nephews; a host of friends from Ewing Senior Day Center and Enable group home where he resided; as well as his Princeton Deliverance church family; and many acquaintances he touched along the way.
