### Reflections

Sastor Earline Barnes departed this life on Sunday, June 21, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. at St. Peter's University Hospital in New Brunswick, New Jersey. Pastor Earline Barnes was born January 28, 1935 to the late Thomas J. and Etta Mae Beattie.

Earline was educated in Mecklenburg County School system in the state of Virginia. She loved reading and any outdoor activities. She had a passion for learning about God at an early age that led to her wanting to seek out God.

Earline was united in Holy Matrimony to her childhood sweetheart, William Henry Barnes, of Chase City, Virginia. To that union eight children were born.

Earline and William moved North in 1961 and a few years later they settled and joined Mount Sinai Fire Baptized Holiness Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Robert Logan. This is where Pastor Earline Barnes accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Saviour. Pastor Barnes loved the Lord and served faithfully under Pastor Logan. In 1981, the church transitioned to Mount Zion FBH Church in Elizabeth, New Jersey under the leadership of the late Pastor Minerva Whaley Steele. There she served in many capacities of the church - usher, choir, missionary and junior pastor; and later God elevated her into the ministry. Around 1981, she was appointed by the late Bishop W.E. Fuller, Jr.

Paster Barnes served faithfully as Pastor of Smyrna Fired Baptized Holiness Church, 2nd Timothy, Palmer's Memorial and finally Faith Temple Holiness Church. Pastor Earline Barnes was a preacher of the highest magnitude. She was a prayer warrior and intercessor and loved people of all walks of life. As a well-rounded Minister of the gospel, she joined The Women AGLOW Association and in her later years she joined The Unified International Interdenominational Fellowship. Her legacy will live on forever.
