

### <u>Obituary</u>

**Ricky** received his elementary and secondary education in the New York City public school system. While attending Brandeis High School in NYC, Ricky excelled in both track & field and basketball. When Ricky graduated from Brandeis High School in 1968, he was awarded a basketball scholarship to Johnson and Whales Junior College in Rhode Island.
