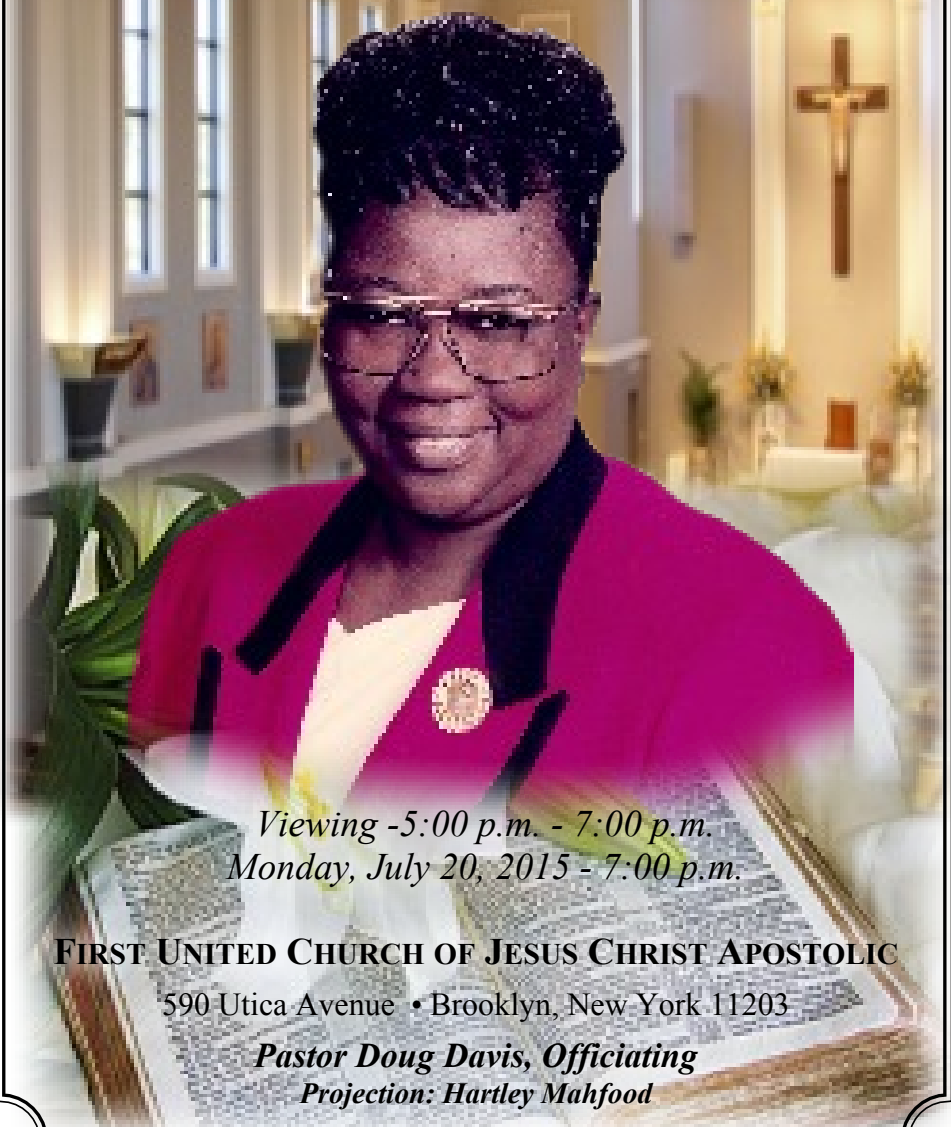

We shall tread the streets of gold



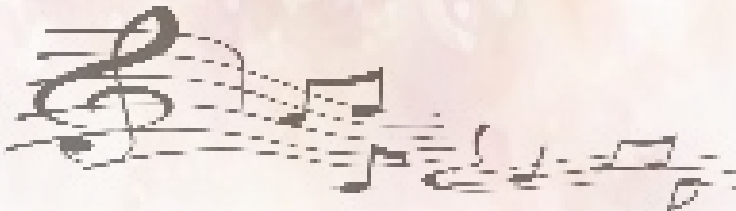
When The Roll Is Called Up Yonder
