Obituary

Violet Adassa Spence Boswell was born in the parish of Westmoreland, Jamaica on the 26th of March, 1921 to George Spence and Albertha Vincent. She was taken to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on the 26th of August, 2015.

Violet was the eldest of five children, three girls and two boys. The family moved to Montego Bay, St. James where Violet began her education at the Chetwood Memorial School. To assist her family, she had to begin work at an early age. Due to the good deeds of her mother Albertha, both Violet and her husband, Lorenzo Boswell were able to secure permanent jobs at the Montego Beach Hotel. She would remain there for many years until she migrated to the United States in 1968.

After her move to the United States, Violet would secure employment with the Palmer Home Health Aide Agency in White Plains, NY. In doing so, she developed years of lasting friendships with both her patients and their families.
