Reflections of Life

Herbert Bradley age 64, of Paterson, New Jersey died peacefully on September 1, 2015. He was born on October 31, 1950 to Josephus and Dorothy Bradley in a small town called Christiana, in the parish of Manchester, Jamaica. He was the first of seven children.

He attended Zion Moravian Primary School, and later Christiana Secondary School, where he obtained his education.
