

Theodore R. Downing, Jr. affectionately known as "Ted", was born on August 24, 1927 in Philadelphia, PA to the late Theodore R. Downing, Sr. and Pocahontas M. (Ward) Downing. Theodore received his education in Philadelphia, PA and later joined the U.S. Navy. After being discharged from the Navy he moved to Paterson, NJ where he was employed for American Paterson Glass Company as a truck driver. He later moved on to work for Pittsburgh Plate Glass (PPG) as a truck driver for thirty years. He retired in 1998.
